

I-90/Valley Line

Improving Public Transit along the I-90 Corridor



Project Description

The I-90 / Valley Line will improve quality and capacity of service along the Interstate 90 corridor between downtown Spokane and Liberty Lake (with a cross-state partnership pilot extension to Coeur d' Alene). Anticipated improvements include expanded park and a new transit center. Expanded night and weekend service will be provided in the corridor.

Budget

Total Project Budget: \$14.9 million

New Park & Ride - \$5,562,000

- State grant - \$2,969,000

New Transit Center - \$8,488,000

- State grant - \$4,244,000

- **Regional connections**
- **Enhanced or relocated Park & Ride amenities such as shelters, lighting and real time information**
- **Improved access to job centers and educational institutions**
